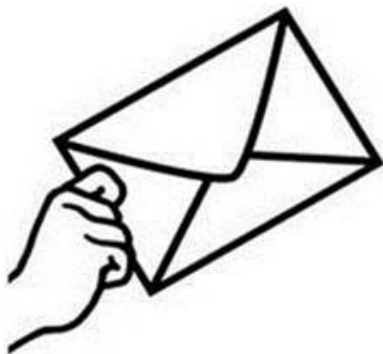
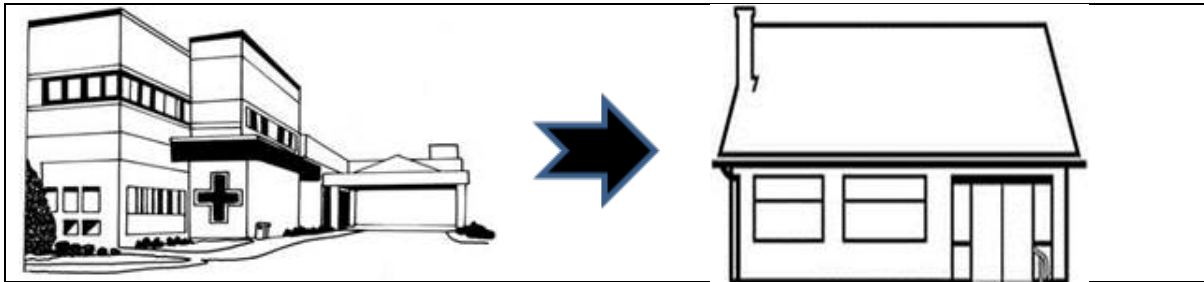

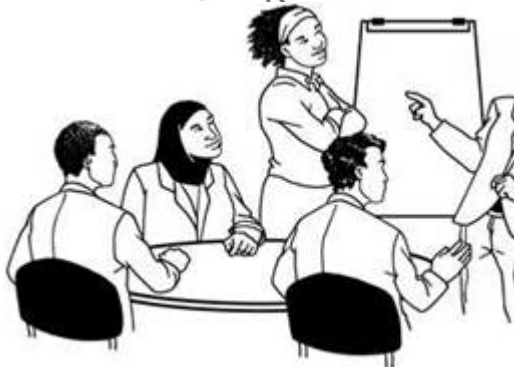

## Working with the secure outreach transition team (SOTT)

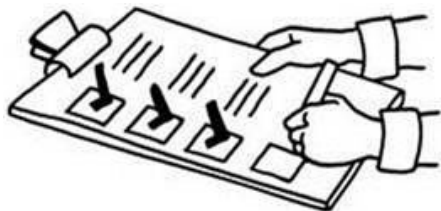


The SOTT will be involved in your care from when you are admitted to hospital.

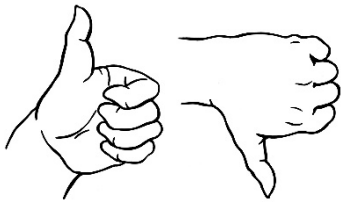
