You have the right to **be involved** in your **care**



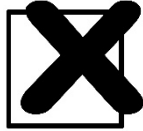
You have the right to **information** in a **way you can understand**

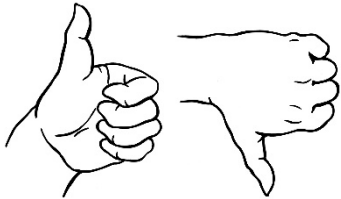
